Hyperion Books publishes general-interest fiction and non-fiction hardcover, trade, and mass-market paperback books for adults and includes the Voice, Hyperion eBook, and Hyperion Audio imprints. Hyperion publishes more than 100 hardcover and paperback books a year, and offers many of its titles as e-books and as audio books through its Hyperion Audio division.

## Bestsellers:

Hyperion's bestselling titles include: *Jacqueline Kennedy: Historic Conversations on Life with John F. Kennedy*; Randy Pausch's *The Last Lecture*, with more than four million copies currently in print; Richard Castle's *Heat Rises*, *Naked Heat*, and *Heat Wave*, based ABC's hit series 'Castle'; *Secretariat* by William Nack, released in conjunction with the Walt Disney Pictures feature film; as well as Mitch Albom's *Have a Little Faith*.

## Upcoming Releases:

Sissy Spacek's memoir *Barefoot Stories*, *Sinner* by Jenny McCarthy, *Those We Love Most* by Lee Woodruff, and upcoming novels from J.R. Mohringer, Mitch Albom, Sandra Lee, and Richard Castle.

## Voice:

Voice, an imprint which publishes fiction and non-fiction books by and about women, has already published such bestsellers as Leslie Bennetts' *The Feminine Mistake*, Kelly Corrigan's *The Middle Place*, Lauren Groff's *The Monsters of Templeton* and *Happy Accidents* by Jane Lynch.

## Disney/ABC Titles:

The synergy of Disney and ABC's networks, studios and distributors extends to Hyperion. Three bestselling Hyperion novels, *Heat Rises*, *Naked Heat* and *Heat Wave*, were inspired by the hit ABC drama 'Castle'; Hyperion's *The Secret Diary of Ashley Juergens* was similarly inspired by the popular ABC Family series 'The Secret Life of the American Teenager.' *Secretariat*, the William Nack novel that was the basis for Disney's major motion picture, became a bestselling paperback novel in 2010, and one of the most beloved characters on ABC's popular daytime soap, General Hospital inspired the novel *The Secret Life of Damian Spinelli* to coincide with the show's 48<sup>th</sup> anniversary.

In non-fiction, Hyperion introduced *Jamie Oliver's Meals in Minutes*, the second cookbook with ties to ABC's Emmy-winning series 'Jamie Oliver's Food Revolution.'

## eBooks:

Hyperion is focused on the digital future, publishing original eBook and enhanced eBooks as well as eBook editions of print titles. Hyperion's bestselling enhanced eBook *Jacqueline Kennedy: Historic Conversations on Life with John F. Kennedy* featured eight and a half hours of audio and twenty-two minutes of video in addition to the text and photographs found in the print edition. With ABC News, Hyperion published an enhanced eBook original, *A Modern Fairy Tale* written by Jane Green to commemorate the royal wedding of William and Kate. Hyperion's bestselling eBooks include: *Heat Wave*, *The Five People You Meet in Heaven* by Mitch Albom, and *The Physick Book of Deliverance Dane* by Katherine Howe.
